### **A \$25.00 APPLICATION FEE MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION FORM.**

Tuition rates are the same for Nebraska residents and non-residents. Tuition is due at the beginning of each semester - September 1 and February 1 each year. The refund policy is effective at the start of each semester. The application fee is non-refundable. For financial aid purposes, the student must complete 3744 total clock hours (101.5 credit hours) with 936 clock hours (24.5 credit hours) completed at 1st year midpoint and 2808 clock hours (76.5 credit hours) completed at 2nd year midpoint before funds will be released. With pre-requisite transfer credits, students graduate with a minimum of 123.5 credits hours which meets the Nebraska Department of Education requirements for an Associate of Applied Science in Radiologic Technology degree. The program must be completed in a maximum time of 150%. If financial aid from another institution was received, a financial aid transcript must be submitted. If no aid was received, a financial aid statement must be submitted identifying that no aid was received. An exit interview/counseling is required. For first time financial aid recipients, new federal guidelines require enrollment and attendance in a program for 30 days prior to release of funds.

The School will provide to you a list of all required books for the 2 years. When purchasing used books, be **sure** you are getting the **newest edition**. The student may expect to pay approximately **\$1100-\$1300** for all books for the 2 years.

Upon acceptance to the program, the student must remit \$100.00 tuition deposit within two weeks to reserve their placement in the class. This deposit applies directly to tuition and is non-refundable.
